## Maple City Trail Closure

**Ogdensburg, NY** – Beginning Tuesday, July 5<sup>th</sup> the Crescent Park portion of the Maple City Trail, between the Oswegatchie Pump House and Fishing Pier, will be closed until further notice. This trail closure will facilitate repairs to the Oswegatchie Seawall and Maple City Trail caused by flooding in 2017 and 2019. The Project includes: removal and reconstruction of approximate 1,200 linear feet of existing shoreline retaining wall along the Oswegatchie River, reconfiguration of approximately 1,900 linear feet of existing pedestrian trail, asphalt paving, tree planting and landscaping, replacement of site lighting and associated electrical power, and related site work. J.E. Sheehan has been selected to complete the construction, which is anticipated to be completed by the end of this year. Repairs will be funded in part by the New York State Resiliency and Economic Development Initiative (REDI).

The trail will be closed in three locations as illustrated in the map below: (1) just south of the Pedestrian Bridge, (2) at the top of the stairs behind the U.S. Post Office, and (3) Mechanic Street just north of Crescent Place.
